WHAT IS CSP?

The Community Solutions Program (CSP) is a yearlong professional leadership development program **fully funded by the U.S. Government** for experienced civil society leaders age 26 - 39 working in **democracy and human rights, environmental issues, gender equality, and peace and conflict resolution**. CSP offers hands-on experience through a four-month **(August - December 2025)** U.S. practicum, advanced leadership and technical skill development, and connection to a diverse, global network of over 800 changemakers positively impacting their communities.

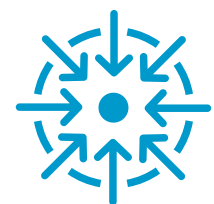
Advance technical skills through a collaboration with a U.S. community-based organization
